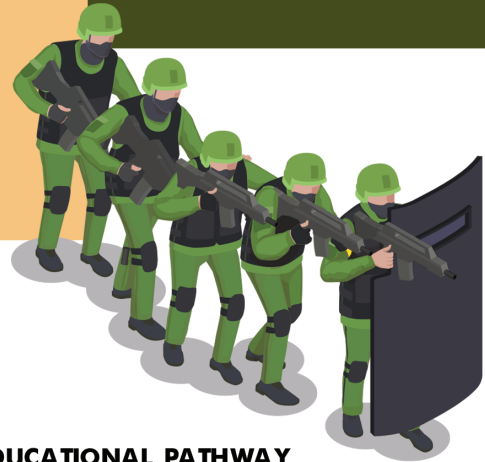
AGNIVEER
