



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Minutes of the meeting of the Project Approval Board held on 19th May, 2020 through Video Conference to consider the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) 2020-21 of Samagra Shiksha for the State of Karnataka.

1) Introduction:

The meeting of the Project Approval Board to consider the Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B) 2020-21 for SAMAGRA SHIKSHA for the State of Karnataka was held on 19.05.2020 through Video Conference. The list of participants who attended the meeting is attached at **Annexure-I**.

2) Initiatives of the State:

Ms. Anita Karwal, Secretary (SE&L) invited Karnataka to give a presentation on School Education in the State. Mr. S. R. Umashankar, Principal Secretary, School Education (Karnataka) gave a presentation which included the following major points:

- a) **Implementation of English Nali Kali:** In 2017, Nali Kali English was piloted in 100 units of 4 districts. In 2019, it expanded to 2000 schools (276 Karnataka Public Schools, 724 English medium schools and 612 best Nali Kali (NK) units in the State). From academic year 2020-21, Grade 1 English Nali Kali will be implemented in all 55,530 Kannada medium and 5,100 Urdu medium schools.
- b) **Karnataka Public Schools (KPS):** Decision by the Government to implement KPS in 1,000 schools in phased manner. The State established 276 integrated schools from pre-primary to senior secondary where total enrolment was increased considerably. Total increase from Pre-primary to PUC-II was around 2,92,350. These schools are brought under the Technology Assisted Learning Programme (TALP) for students studying in Secondary and Higher Secondary.
- c) **Pre-School:** 276 pre-primary sections started in 276 Karnataka Public Schools 'Balasnehi' classrooms - to provide conducive environment to facilitate learning. Total 8,936 children got admission in these pre-schools. Admission limited to 30 per section. Curriculum developed in collaboration with UNICEF, Education experts, NGO partners, DSERT & State Resource Persons.
- d) **Student Achievement Tracking System (SAT):** The Students Achievement Tracking System ("Shikshana Kirana") - a project to track every child enrolling in school, by unique identity and name, for their regularity, identify dropouts, transfers and their academic performance. The system enabled the State to track drop outs, eliminate duplications in grant in aid schools, academic progress of each student, promotion to
