Sub:- Providing internet facility in all the Schools in which ICT Labs and Smart Class rooms are already functional - Reg.

Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) is increasingly becoming indispensable part of the education system. The use of ICT and digital initiatives would help transform the process of teaching and learning from the traditional instructional teacher-centred endeavour to a learner-cantered approach. ICT enabled tools and digital contents caters the requirement of the teachers to equip and acquaint themselves to the use of technology for pedagogical practices which would lead to improved teaching and learning efficiency. In view of new education policy and to address the digital divide, a strong and stable ICT infrastructure is very much needed.

- 2. You may be aware that that the ICT and Digital Initiatives component of Samagra Shiksha covers Government and Aided Schools having classes VI to XII. Under this component financial assistance is provided for establishing ICT Lab and Smart Classrooms in schools.
- 3. As on date, ICT Labs are approved in 123906 schools and Smart classrooms are approved in 89291 schools. Total 1482565 TABs have been sanctioned to the teachers dealing primary classes.
- 4. It is observed that still in 23628 Schools in which already ICT Lab is established, Internet facility has not been provided by the State / UT Government and similarly, in 8002 Schools in which Smart Class rooms are already set up, Internet facility has not been provided by the State / UT Government (State / UT wise details are enclosed).
- 5. As per Samagra Shiksha norms an amount of Rs. 2.4 Lakhs for established ICT Lab an amount of Rs.0.38 Lakhs for established Smart class room is being released as Recurring expenditure every year as per the proposal of the State / UT.
- 6. Since recurring grant is being released for already established ICT Labs and Smart Class rooms, from which Internet connection also has to be provided, all the Secretaries looking after Education are requested to take steps for providing Internet connection in all the Schools in which ICT Labs and Smart Class rooms are established at the earliest.
