



- **EK BHARAT SHRESTHA BHARAT**

The program aims to enhance interaction and promote mutual understanding between people of different states and union territories through the concept of state/UT pairing. Under the Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat (EBSB) program, month-wise calendars of activities are prepared by KVS (HQ) to provide opportunities for understanding the art and culture of the paired state, fostering mutual respect for different cultures.
