



On 3 <sup>rd</sup> June 2024 The Department of School Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India, signed an MoU with the National Book Trust under the aegis of Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education in New Delhi today to create an institutional framework for the Digital Library Platform, Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya. Rashtriya e-Pustakalya, seeks to instill a lifelong love of reading among Indian children and youth by offering over 1,000 non-academic books to children and adolescents published by over 40 reputed publishers in more than 22 languages besides English. The Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya app will be available for download on both Android and iOS devices
2	Advisory for all Children with Special Needs (CwSN)	In a significant step towards realizing the vision of the NEP 2020, the Department of School Education & Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education, Government of India, issued a comprehensive advisory to all States and Union Territories (UTs) on 7 June 2024. The advisory emphasizes the need for necessary measures to ensure that all Children with Special Needs (CwSN), studying in government/government-aided inclusive, home-based or special schools are provided with RTE entitlements, such as free uniforms, free textbooks, interventions under the Inclusive Education

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		<p>component of Samagra Shiksha Scheme, and mid-day meal under PM POSHAN, if need be in the form of dry ration or Direct Benefit Transfer.</p> <p>The advisory specifically addresses the nutritional needs of the CwSN students of Special Schools under the Social Welfare Department and also students with severe and multiple disabilities enrolled in home-based education by extending the coverage of its centrally sponsored PM Poshan scheme; either in the form of dry rations or DBT as the case may be.</p> <p>The aim is to ensure the NEP 2020 objective of providing access to quality education for all including CwSN thereby realizing their Right to Education and promoting inclusive education.</p>
3	Menstrual hygiene facilities during examinations	<p>On 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024, the Department of School Education &amp; Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education, announced proactive measures to ensure the health, dignity, and academic success of female students during the 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Board Examinations. 4	<p>Virtual Orientation Programme for PM SHRI Schools</p>	<p>National Council for Teacher Education, conducted a five-day virtual orientation program on the National Mission for Mentoring (NMM) and the National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST) for teachers of PM SHRI schools from 29 States/UTs/KVS/NVS across the country covering more than 1 lakh teachers. CBSE has organized a Stakeholder Interaction Programme on 25 June, 2024 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi to comprehensively assess the opinions, concerns, and perspectives of schools regarding the implementation of NCFFS-2022 and NCFSE-2023. Principals of affiliated schools from across the globe were present at the programme.
