Subject:-Samagra Shiksha –Addendum to the Minutes of the meeting of the Project Approval Board held on 22nd March, 2023 to consider the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) 2023-24 of Samagra Shiksha for the State of Andhra Pradesh - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the State Government's letter No.SS-13024/2/2023-CIVIL SEC-SSA dated 11th August, 2023 wherein it has been mentioned that in the Supplementary grant of AWP & B 2022-23 an allocation of Rs. 117.91 crores was made under BIGS programmes to fill up infrastructure gaps identified as per U-DISE⁺ to the State of Andhra Pradesh (Rs.89.03 crores for construction of compound walls, toilets etc. under Non-recurring budget plus Rs. 28.88 crores as Recurring Budget towards Minor Repairs) as per the minutes circulated on 25.01.2023. It has been further pointed out that budget approved in spill of AWP&B 2023-24 is available only for works attached under Non-Recurring budget and budget under Recurring i.e.. **Rs.28.88 crores** has not been carried over as a spill over budget for the year 2023-24 due to which the payments are yet to be released for the designated works.
