## Class $X$ results of CBSE declared; Trivandrum region records highest pass percentage

New Delhi, $15{ }^{\text {th }}$ July 2020

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) declared Class X results today. Trivandrum performed best amongst all regions with $99.28 \%$ pass percentage followed by Chennai region with $98.95 \%$ while Bengaluru stands at third position with $98.23 \%$ pass percentage. A total of $18,73,015$ students appeared in the exam out of which $17,13,121$ students passed the exam. Overall pass percentage of this year is 91.46 .
