





Felicitation of National SVP 2021-22 Winners



Recognizing excellence in Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in schools



In 2014, The Ministry of Human Resource Development (now Ministry of Education), Government of India launched 'Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya' (SBSV) initiative, to ensure that every school in country has a set of functioning, well-maintained water, sanitation and hygiene facilities for girls and boys both. The initiative lays emphasis on promoting safe and appropriate hygiene practices in schools and behavior among children.

Ministry of Education instituted the Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar (SVP) in 2016–17, to identify, inspire and celebrate excellence in water, sanitation, and hygiene practices in Schools. SVP includes comprehensive WASH in schools' indicators that contribute towards education and clean water and sanitation linked targets of the Sustainable development Goals (SDGs).

Information Technology enabled, 5-star WASH in schools bench marking approach-based SVP, has provided each school of the country an opportunity to get assessed and rewarded on basis of defined sets of parameters. India has privilege of being country, that facilitate the ranking of the schools at a very high scale, along with recognizing, inspiring the schools for exemplary work on cleanliness at district, state, and national level, at such a scale.

In line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, SVP provides a ready platform to inform and creatively engage children as responsible citizen in addressing prevailing challenges such as of water, sanitation, environment and climate changes, both withing and beyond the schools

The Ministry of Education has organized 3 rounds of SVP in 2016-17 then SVP 2017-18 followed by the most recent SVP 2021-22 which has seen an overwhelming 30% increase of participation from 2016-17.

Present Booklet presents a glimpse of the exemplary initiatives taken by the National level SVP 2021-22 Award winning schools from the respective States and Union Territories.
