

Embracing Innovation and Culture: A Life-Changing Experience "The Thrill of Scientific Exploration in Japan"

The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education is sending 20 school students of class 11-12 and 2 supervisors to Japan to participate in Sakura Science Program 2024 where 5 other countries are also joining them. This one week program between 20-26 October, 2024 will provide a unique opportunity for young students of science to explore Japan's cutting-edge science, technology, and cultural advancements, contributing to their intellectual growth and global awareness. India joined the Sakura Program first in 2016. Since then, 553 students and 85 supervisors from India have visited Japan under this initiative. The most recent batch visited Japan in June, 2024. For the 2024 edition of the program, students have been selected from Navodaya Vidyalayas and PRERANA program and they are very enthusiastic for visiting Japan.
